

ELL DEMOGRAPHICS IN REVERE

- ⌘ 1305 ELL students (increase of more than 154 students from last Oct 1, 2014)
- ⌘ 17.3% of district population; Most ELLs are born in the United States.
- ⌘ Schools with the largest ELL populations: Hill School (29%); Garfield Elem (28%);
⌘ Beachmont (26%); Lincoln (23%); Paul Revere (22%); Whelan (17%). All others less than 15%.
⌘ Revere High School (12.5%)
- ⌘ 66% of ELLs are Spanish speaking; 15% Arabic speaking
- ⌘ 28 Languages represented in ELL Cohort of 1275 students
- ⌘ 26% of ELLs at Secondary level; 74% of ELLs at Elementary level
- ⌘ 55% of all students in grades k-12 first home language is not English
- ⌘ Total of 49 languages represented in k-12 first home language
